











Tutorial Video

Hello, the lucky owner of the cool crochet kit!

Just several hours of your attention, work and eagerness and you'll have a Sweet Donut in your hands!


This cute donut is perfect for home decoration. You may create a lovely interior piece.

We made a detailed video of this workshop on our **YouTube channel**: **Bobilon** for your convenience.


Open the "Crochet kits" playlist and choose your workshop! Enjoy your crocheting!

The kit contains:

- 2 yarn balls in different colors
- 35 colorful yarn pieces for decoration
- 5.5yds / 5m yarn for stitching together
- 1 metal crocheting hook
- 1 plastic needle
- 1 plastic stitch marker
- 100g of silicone stuffing




We will use the following abbreviations for your convenience:



SC - single crochet CS - chain stitch SI st - slipped stitch INC - increase

Basic stages of the Donut crocheting:

- 1. Donut part crocheting
- 2. Donut decorating
- 3. Stitching parts together



1. Donut part crocheting

We start crocheting with a slip knot.

To make a starting loop - fold the yarn to make a loop. Catch the yarn through the loop. Pull it through. Pull the ends to tighten the slip knot (Pic. 1, 2, 3, 4).








Wrap the yarn around your hook, pull the yarn down and through the loop on your hook.

You've just created your first CS (Chain Stitch) (Pic. 5, 6)! Now repeat the same pattern till you have 20 CS.










Now we join our chain to the 1st stitch (Pic. 7).

Insert your hook through, yarn over and pull it through the loop on your hook. That was a SI st (Slip Stitch) (Pic. 8, 9).





Be careful and please do not twist the chain!



You will work in rounds, but do not join at the end of each round.


Round 1: make 20 SC (Single Crochet). Here is how it looks like. Insert hook into center of next chain stitch. Draw yarn through the CS and up onto the hook. There are now 2 loops on hook.

Bring yarn over hook from back to front and draw it through both loops on hook. One loop remains on the hook, and you have just made one SC (Single Crochet) (Pic. 10, 11).









Repeat it all the way around (Pic.12).

Grab a stitch marker and put it at the end of the 1st Round since you are working in a continuous round (Pic. 13).

Round 2: crochet 1 SC into first two SCs. Then make an INC (Increase): 2SC into one SC (Pic. 14).

Repeat it all the way around. Replace the stitch marker to one Round higher at the end of the 2nd Round.

Round 3: crochet 1 SC into three SCs, then make an INC: 2SC into one SC (Pic. 15).








Lifehack! Here is super useful lifehack for you in crocheting all next Rounds so you won't get confused.

In each next Round, you make plus 1 SC. First, find INC in the previous Round. Then make INC in this Round on top of it but moving 1 stitch left (Pic. 16).



Round 1: 20 SC without INC.

Round 2 - Round 8: INC according to Pic. 16.

Round 9: only SC without INC.



Round 9: crochet 1 SI st at the end of this Round (Pic. 17, 18).



Now cut the yarn thread (Pic.19), pull it out (Pic. 20) and hide the end as is shown on the following pictures (Pic. 21, 22, 23, 24).



Hide all the remaining ends between the neighboring loops using a hook or needle (Pic.25).

Crochet Second part of Sweet Donut in the same way.

2. Donut decorating

Now we start decorating our ready-made parts. Create sprinkles by stitching 35 colorful yarn pieces on top of the donut (Pic. 26, 27, 28).








3. Stitching parts together

Donut is almost ready!



Turn the donut parts back to the correct side and begin to whipstitch them together using a plastic needle. For this particular whipstitch method, you have a special yarn of different color. Now insert needle from back to front through inside loops only, bring the needle through and around. Repeat this across (Pic. 29, 30, 31).







Continue to stitch together and fill with toy stuffing as you go. Do not overfill (Pic. 32).

Finally, when you have finished filling and stitching the donut, make sure to hide all the yarn ends (Pic. 33).


